



PUBLIC NOTICE

Please be advised that the Council of the Town of Kirkland Lake has updated its Hawker Peddler bylaw to regulate the sale of goods and services by transient salespersons.

Transient hawkers, peddlers, and salespersons require a licence from the Town of Kirkland Lake in order to operate in Town.

Please contact the Town of Kirkland Lake in the event that a door-to-door salesperson visits your home to ensure that they have obtained a Transient Hawker, Peddler and Salesperson licence and are allowed to operate in Kirkland Lake.

Please note that you may ask a door-to-door salesperson to present their Hawker, Peddler, Salesperson license to you to ensure that they are following the regulations of the Town's bylaw.

Please Note:

NO ONE has the right to enter your home unless you have invited them in.

NO ONE has the right to stay in your home when you have asked them to leave.

CALL 911 if a door-to-door salesperson insists on entering your home without your permission or will not leave your home when asked.

In accordance with the Consumer Protection Act of Ontario, a consumer may, without any reason, cancel a direct agreement at any time from the date of entering into the agreement until 10 days after receiving the written copy of the agreement.
