THE DANGERS OF SNOW FORTS ARE REAL!

Why is this fort dangerous?

The roof could fall in and bury you under the snow. It is also close to a road or driveway.

Each year, children die as a result of collapsing snow forts. While it is possible to build struturally sound snow forts, accidents can still happen.

The construction of snow forts is an inherently dangerous activity due to the possibility of collapse, and they are not visible during Winter Maintenance Activities such as plowing, snow removal, or scarifying.

MAINTAINED SIDEWALKS

Residents are reminded that maintained sidewalks in Town must not be used for snow storage or parking. Persons who fail to keep sidewalks clear to allow for safe pedestrian traffic will be subject to a \$175.00 fine.




Obey the Rules of the Road... WATCH FOR THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PERSON!!
