

Council Decisions - October 15, 2024

- Council approved the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on October 1, 2024 and those as presented by Committees of Council and Regional/Local Boards.
- Council authorized and approved a new <u>Sale and Other Disposition of Municipal Land Policy</u>.

- Council authorized an amendment to the legal description and approved (by <u>by-law</u>) to enter into an Easement Agreement with Hydro One Networks Inc. over part of Mining Claims L1439 and L2728 (Rick's Trail).
- Council approved a <u>Maintenance and Liability Agreement</u> between the Town and the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 87 for the management of the Cenotaph on Duncan St.
- Council authorized the implementation of a Community Beautification Survey.

- Council received an <u>Interim Financial Report Year to Date as at June 30, 2024</u> from the Treasurer.
- Mayor Wight brought Notices of a Motion for the following:
 - "AMCTO Recommendations for Updates to the Municipal Elections Act"; and
 - "AMO OMA Joint Health Resolution Campaign".
- Council authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the execution of a Client/Engineer Agreement for Professional Consulting Services with EXP Services Inc. for an engineering review of the 2024 Flood and concept remedial options for the Town of Kirkland Lake as presented in Report <u>2024-FES-003</u>.
- Mayor Wight proclaimed October 29, 2024 as "World Stroke Day" in the Town of Kirkland Lake.
