

## Council Decisions - March 4, 2025

The following is a summary of actions and decisions from Council at its Regular Meeting held March 4, 2025. A recording of the meeting can be viewed on the Town's YouTube channel. - Council approved the Minutes of its Regular Meeting held on <u>February 18, 2025</u>, and received those as presented by Committees of Council and Regional/Local Boards.
- Council received a delegation from the Kirkland Lake Minor Hockey Association (KLMHA) supporting a request to extend the ice season into April.
- Council received the Town's 2025 Corporate Business Plan.
- Council received the <u>2025 Town Budget</u>, as <u>tabled</u>, and directed that a <u>Public Meeting</u> be held on March 18, 2025 at 4:40 PM to allow for public comment.

**Note:** Those interested in participating in person at the Public Meeting can attend Council Chambers and present themselves to speak. Those interested in participating virtually must contact the Municipal Clerk to obtain meeting credentials.

 Council received the <u>2024 Summary of Remuneration and Expenses</u> for Board Members/Appointments and Elected Officials.

Council delegated their authority to the Director of Public Works in the execution of a <u>Facility Use Agreement</u> with Team Northern Throttle (TNT) For Family Events for the use of the Kirkland Lake Airport to host their annual Summer Drag Race events inclusively from June 18-23, 2025 and July 16-21, 2025.

Note: The execution by-law will be considered for passage on March 18, 2025.

 Council authorized to extend the <u>2024-2025 Winter Ice Season</u> and directed to amend the recommendation to identify that, annually, the ice season be extended to the end of April moving forward.

- Council resolved to support John Vanthof, MPP Timiskaming-Cochrane's <u>Updated Northern</u> <u>Plan for Highway Safety</u>.
- Council resolved to support the <u>resolution</u> from the Eastern Ontario Warden's Caucus (EOWC) supporting senior levels of Canadian Government to negotiate with Government of the United States of America on Trade Tariffs.
