

Council Decisions - August 13, 2024

- Council approved the Minutes of its <u>Public</u> and <u>Regular</u> Meetings held on July 16, 2024 and those as presented by Committees of Council and Regional/Local Boards.
- Item 5.1. was not considered by Council as there was no seconder on the matter.
- Council approved (by <u>by-law</u>) an amendment to Zoning By-Law No. 21-032 to rezone lands identified for 39 Second Street East from "Institutional (I)" to "Residential Medium Density – Special (R2-02).
- Council received a <u>legal opinion</u>, and approved (by <u>by-law</u>) <u>amendments</u> to the Town's Fireworks By-Law.

NOTE: Council will be considering <u>housekeeping amendments</u> to the Fireworks By-Law at its September 3, 2024 Regular Meeting.

- Council received an <u>amended request</u> from Agnico Eagle Mines Limited and approved to
 extend their original request as presented on <u>July 16, 2024</u> to a 18-month noise exemption
 and authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the execution of an Easement Agreement with Agnico Eagle Mine
 Ltd. over a portion of 600 Archer Drive to support their <u>Pole Hole Drilling Exploration Project</u>;
- Council received an <u>information report</u> on the Town's Operational Key Performance Indicators (O-KPIs) for the Second Quarter of 2024.
- Council received an update on the FoodCycler ™ Pilot Program.
- Council received a Municipal Accommodations Tax (MAT) quarterly update.
- Council authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the signing of the Contribution Agreement with Ontario's Ministry of Transportation for the <u>2024-2025 Connecting Link Project.</u>
- Council authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the signing of the Paving Services Agreement with Miller Paving Limited for <u>2024 Road Work</u> at Churchill Dr. from Duncan Ave. to Fifth Street, and Duncan Ave. N. from Prospect Ave. to Goodfish Rd..
- Council authorized (by <u>by-law</u>) the signing of the Agreement with Miller Paving Limited for the 2023-2024 Connecting Links Project, specifically the resurfacing and pedestrian crossover construction on Highway 66.
- Mayor Wight <u>proclaimed</u> August 31, 2024 as "International Overdose Awareness Day" in the Town of Kirkland Lake.
